Principal's Report



Dear Families,

A huge thank you to everyone for supporting our students' learning and wellbeing this term. It's hard to believe that we are at the end of Term 3, and already planning for 2025!

Term 4 resumes on Monday October 7th. It will be a really busy term with some exciting things happening, including construction of our Basketball Court roof, the 2024 Somers Arts Fair (which will take place at Coolart Homestead on Sunday Nov 17th), our Year 56 Camp to Peninsula Outdoors in Merricks, our four-year School Review, Prep Transition, End of Year Concert and Year 6 graduation. I hope everyone gets plenty of rest over the holidays, because it will be a huge Term 4!

Improving Student Writing

Increasing the percentage of students performing above the expected level in writing has been a focus for our school this year, and we have set a target of greater than 25% of students achieving above age-expected levels in writing by the end of 2024.

Our end of Term 3 teacher judgment data shows a cohort average of 28% of students performing above age-expected levels in Writing. In our Prep cohort, 47% of students are being assessed by their teachers as being above the expected level in writing.

These results have been achieved through a strong focus on building teachers' shared understanding of the writing curriculum and standards, utilising assessment to identify student needs, explicit teaching of writing skills, consistent weekly structures, and ensuring students are emotionally





and cognitively engaged in writing by utilising writing contexts that are meaningful to our students, and helping students understand what they have to do to be successful.

Our NAPLAN results in writing this year indicate 86% of students assessed as being 'Strong' or 'Exceeding' in Year 3 (compared to 81% in similar and network schools) an increase of 33% compared with 2023. Our year 5 results also showed improvement. Importantly, no students in years 3 or 5 were assessed as "Needing Additional Support".

Attendance

Across the school, our students are currently projecting 1.8 days of unapproved absence by the end of 2024. This is under our target of 2 days – we thank families for continuing to prioritise their children's attendance, and avoid unnecessary days absent.

Arts Fair Update

Our 2024 Arts Fair at Coolart on November 17th promises to be a huge event! Money raised this year will go towards ensuring our students have access to technology and literacy resources to support their learning at school. We ask that all families contribute to our fair each year as our major fundraising event. Early next term our roster will be accessible for families to indicate when and how they can help out on the day.


